EXPERIENCE

Mr. Clark is a Senior Associate and Project Facilities Professional with Terracon. Formerly, Mr. Clark was a partner of Building Exterior Solutions, Inc. (BES), founded in 2008. His expertise includes the evaluation of existing roofing, waterproofing and wall systems on commercial, industrial, and institutional buildings. These evaluations include locating sources of moisture infiltration, analysis of system conditions and system failures, as well as, repair designs. His work includes the initial design of roofing and waterproofing systems which incorporates drawings and specifications, peer review of roofing and waterproofing systems, and construction observations and field reporting. He is a Registered Roof Observer (RRO) and Construction Document Technologist (CDT) with more than 20 years' experience in roofing, sheet metal, and construction consultation.

Prior to BES, he was employed by Wiss, Janney, Elstner Associates, Inc. from 2003 through 2008 specializing in roofing and waterproofing consulting. Mr. Clark performed peer design reviews and forensic evaluations of roofing and waterproofing systems. He developed new construction and repair designs including the preparation of drawings and specifications. Additionally, he performed construction phase services, such as construction observations, submittal reviews, addressing field conditions, and construction administration services.

Prior to joining WJE, Mr. Clark worked as a Project Manager for a contracting firm specializing in federal government contracting. He completed roofing and waterproofing projects across the country for the United States Air Force, United States Coast Guard, the Department of Veterans Affairs, and the Department of Labor. These projects include roof repair and replacement, installation of sheet metal systems, and the design and installation of waterproofing systems.

Previously, Mr. Clark was Vice President and co-owner of a commercial and residential roofing contracting company. He helped to expand the company from 3 employees and \$300,000 in gross sales in 1991 to 60 employees and 4.1 million dollars in gross sales by 1996. His responsibilities included estimating and project management, service department supervision, business development, as well as implementation of the safety program.
